Publishing news from the President:

I have contacted the HIGGINSON BOOK COMPANY and the information in this December newsletter is for all the membership to be aware of the price in order to place updated book orders through C. Wallace Gladney our treasurer.

In order to be in the first order, you must send your order for your number of books with your check for that price, to C. Wallace Gladney by the deadline date 10 January 2003.

The publishers tell me that since we are such a large database the soft covers would not hold up. So we now have: 1,254 pages at 5 cents per page which is \$62.70. \$20.00 for Hard Covers, Two (2) Volumes: with Gladney Vol I; Vol II on the Spine -- blank front cover. Blue color, (as all reprints would be blue and not the red which we could choose for the initial order. I felt we needed all updates the same color whether we ordered them now or in 2 years.), \$7.50 for individual posting for a total of \$90.20 per 2 volume book sent to your address.

Details on shipping:

\$7.50 for ONE BOOK per same address
\$2.00 FOR EACH ADDITIONAL BOOK per same address.
IE: in my 6 books order I must add for 5 extra books - \$10.00
My (Bettye's) order will be:

6 books at \$62.70= \$376.20 +
6 bindings at \$20.00 = \$120.00 +
posting of \$7.50 + \$10.= \$17.50 = \$513.70 for 6 books to one address

Each individual will have their orders posted (mailed) by the publisher. No orders will come to C.Wallace, Terri, Tim, or me, except our own.. Delivery will be from 8-12 WEEKS after Higginson receives the hard copy of the book and our orders.

I hope I have explained this carefully. The most important thing is to decide how many books you wish to purchase and fill out the form with your return address and check to C. Wallace Gladney.
