Denson stated that his great grandparents were Thomas Gladney & Mary Jane Ussery Gladney and that his grandparents were Melinda Jane Gladney Pound & Jim Pound, these Samuel line ancestors of Randolph Co., Al. being shown on p.22-GIA. Giving a bit of update info, Denson said that he was born Sept. 26, 1911 in Randolph Co., Al. where he lived all of his life until August 1983 when he moved to Auburn, Al.===Thank you, Denson...your great grandfather Thomas and my great grandfather James (actually James Hugh Gladney, Sr.) were brothers.

AUGUST 8, 1984 We might remember this date as the kickoff of "OPERATION GIA"...the genealogical updating of our Gladneys In America family The purpose...a supplementary edition of the Gladneys In America genealogy by MILDRED GLADNEY ARNOLD. What YOU do now in support of this "Operation GIA" effort can be a blessing to your remote descendants. ===On 6-26-84 I received from Mrs. Arnold two unbound copies of the Gladneys In America genealogy book. Using a decimal numbering system which I devised and discussed with Mrs. Arnold at Sardis, Ms., I completed my work yesterday in assigning a number to each Gladney descendant shown in the 108 pages of GIA genealogy tables, probably well over 1500 names. Today, I mailed one of the GIA copies back to Mrs. Arnold in Atlanta, retaining the other copy myself so that I may assist her further if necessary. === Information on Family Group Forms which you and other descendants will complete and submit for the Operation GIA program will be correlated by Mrs. Arnold and her daughters LINDA GRILLS and PRICILLA DAVIS to a decimally numbered ancestor of your line shown in the original genealogy tables. Mrs. Arnold has much other interesting information and material which she wants to correlate for possible inclusion in the supplementary genealogy. This system, which should be quite adaptable to later computerization, is a plan that will again entail much "labor of love." We must also be prepared and willing to help defray some of Mrs. Arnold's expenses if necessary...a reason for increasing our GIA treasury fund. Bill, Jr. has informed me that the balance stood at \$2311.00 on 7-6-84! === Every one of you should have, or have available to you, a copy of the Gladneys In America genealogy book containing the family genealogy tables mentioned above. don't have a copy, try to send \$25.00 to Gladney Book Company, P.O. Box 13, Kennesaw, Georgia 30144, and Mrs. Arnold will mail you a copy of this cherished family record-history. ===When I received my copy of the GIA book two years ago, I found my great grandfather James Gladney on p.22-GIA as the last ancestor shown in my line, my line therefore having been "lost" for several generations. The information about him and his family being incomplete in the book, I was fortunate in having his old Bible record and used the information therein to complete a Family Group Form for him and his wife and 4 children. another Bible record to complete a form for my grandparents and their 15 children. A family group form was then completed for my parents showing my sister and me. I continued by completing my own two forms, one for each of my two marriages. Finally, I completed a form for my married daughter showing her husband and my grandson, a 10th generation Gladney descendant in America. Thus, I brought my lineage up to date. After this work on my line, I completed a number of other family group forms for my sister, nieces and nephews, aunts and uncles and cousins. A form should be completed for each marriage of a descendant. Mrs. Arnold already has typed copies of my completed work - a big package in itself, ready for inclusion in a supplementary GIA edition.

(3) MAKE ONE CLEAR PHOTOCOPY OF EACH OF YOUR COMPLETED FAMILY GROUP FORMS AND MAIL TO MRS. MILDRED ARNOLD, P.O. BOX 13, KENNESAW, GEORGIA 30144 AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. (4) AFTER MAKING PHOTOCOPIES OF YOUR WORK TO BE RETAINED BY YOU OR OTHER CLOSE PARTICI-PATING RELATIVES, PLEASE SEND ME YOUR ORIGINAL SHEETS WITH THE PUNCHED HOLES AT ONE END. These original sheets will be included in our new Gladneys In America "Book of Remembrance" which some of you saw at the recent family reunion. This beautifully engraved expandable binder, which I ordered from The Everton Publishers, is designed for these Family Group Sheets and other family material. It is my gift to the the Family and will pass from GIAFA president to president. Once we have your family group sheets in the Book of Remembrance, descendants may submit supplementary sheets as necessary to always keep their Gladneys In America family genealogical information up to date. === TELL OTHER GLADNEY DESCENDANTS WHO MAY NOT BE ON OUR GIA MAILING LIST ABOUT "OPERATION GIA" AND THE NEED FOR THEM TO COMPLETE THE FAMILY GROUP SHEETS. You will be given plenty of time for your work and submission of your information BUT A DEADLINE WILL BE GIVEN LATER... Do not be left out!
