Throughout all this time and agony, she remained an involved and committed mother to Bart and wife to Michael. Her participation in the BMPC Senior Choir and several choir trips were central to her wellbeing for many years.

Miraculously in May of this year, Pamela and Michael found a cure for her RSD and Pam was relatively pain free for the first time in 23 years. For the past six months she has been actively participating in physical therapy, taking trips around the United States to see her family, planning travels to Europe and Central America and working on other changes to Michael's and her life
