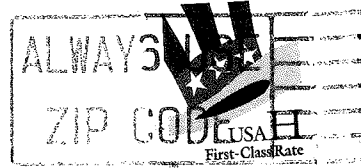


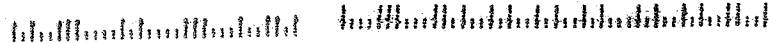

A rough price is \$100.00 to 150.00 per person per day. This does not include airfare which is around \$725.00.

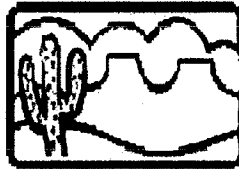
- 1 Depart September 25/26 and return Oct 9 .

Sidney Eugene Mitchell, Sr.
March 18, 1925-February 5, 1999

Sidney E. (Sid) Mitchell of Chickasaw County, MS died February 5 at St. Joseph Hospital after emergency heart surgery. Mr. Mitchell is survived by his second wife; Phylis J. Mitchell, three children; Karen Eugenia Mitchell, Jenny Claire Mitchell Davis, Sidney Eugene Mitchell, Jr. , and one granddaughter; Kathryn Lynn Davis.

He is also survived by three siblings. They are Beckett Gladney Mitchell of TN; Mary Maudine Mitchell Carney of West VA; and Ruby Allene Mitchell Springer, of MS.

Sid Mitchell was inducted into the US Army in 1943. He was a member of Company C, 333rd Infantry, which fought in Central Europe, and participated in the campaigns of Ardennes and Rhineland. His decorations included the Bronze Star of Valor, the Ameto Medal and the good Conduct Medal

Sidney Mitchell married Catherine Delores Stewart (1924-1976) of Houston , MS in 1947. He graduated from University of Kentucky, College of Civil Engineering in 1951 and began working full-time for Cecil C. Harp Engineers. He formed his own company, Mitchell Engineers, in 1978.

The Fairfield Motel in Winnsboro, SC has not yet re-opened following the fire, which destroyed the guest-rooms last summer. The meeting room, which was unaffected by the fire, will be used for the Friday afternoon welcome reception and the Saturday night business meeting and banquet.

Reservations for lodging are the responsibility of the individual and should be made by 1
